#### World Hovercraft Championships, 2002

Early in March 2001 the World Hovercraft Federation received a formal proposal from the Hovercraft Club of America via its President, Cecil Scalf to hold the 2002 World Hovercraft Championships in the United States of America on September 13<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>, 2002. This proposal together with a voting form was delivered to the WHF voting members with a deadline for response of April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2001. I am happy to report that the voting was in favour of the American proposal and the 2002 WHC will be held at the Illinois State Fairgrounds in DuQuoin, Illinois, USA. Start making your travel plans!

The return on this vote was very encouraging with 61.5% of the possible votes cast! It is heartening to see the maintained interest in the WHF and its activities as exhibited by this vote return. The overwhelming support for the Hovercraft Club of America's WHC bid should also be mentioned as *all votes cast were in favour of the proposal!* 

#### **Financial**

It is that time again – when the country WHF membership fees are due. As per Article 5C of the WHF Constitution, Annual Membership fees are due for the year 2001. Please submit \$20US to the WHF office. In the past, I have asked that you send International Money orders payable to the World Hovercraft Federation. However, several European member countries have found that the fees for procuring an International Money Order can often be more than the value of the money order itself!! To defray this extra cost, several member countries preferred to send a \$20US bank note well concealed within a standard envelope. Please choose whichever method you'd prefer, however, the WHF cannot accept responsibility for cash lost in the international post. Please also remember that each country <u>must</u> pay annual dues to remain a part of the World Hovercraft Federation. Failure to pay your dues may result in expulsion from the federation and the inability to have pilots from your country compete in future World Hovercraft Championships.

#### **WHF Achievement Award**

There were no proposals for the WHF Achievement Award hence no selection procedure was done at the Weston Park meeting. Please let the WHF know how you feel about this proposed award. The purpose is to recognise individual achievement for the advancement of hovercraft on a global scale.
