
WORLD HOVERCRAFT CHAMPIONSHIPS 2016

World Chovercraft Championships 2016.

We are very please to inform you that the Hovercraft Club of Great Britain (HCGB) have confirmed the dates and venue for our next World Championships. These will be held from **Wednesday the 27th until Sunday the 31st of July 2016** at Tamworth in Staffordshire which is close to Birmingham. The dates have been carefully chosen to coincide as far as possible with school holidays around the world in an attempt to allow as many of our younger drivers as possible to attend. The venue is an extensive site with a first class racing circuit. It also has a restaurant and excellent camping facilities. Provision to off load containers etc., will also be made available. The HCGB have indicated they have a small fund available which they are prepared to use to support drivers and craft that have substantial distances to travel.

These World Championships will form part of the HCGB's 50th year celebrations. There will be many other related events commencing on the Monday the 18th of July. These will include cruising related events based around South East England neat the river Thames estuary. The HCGB extend a warm invitation to all to join with them in their celebrations.
