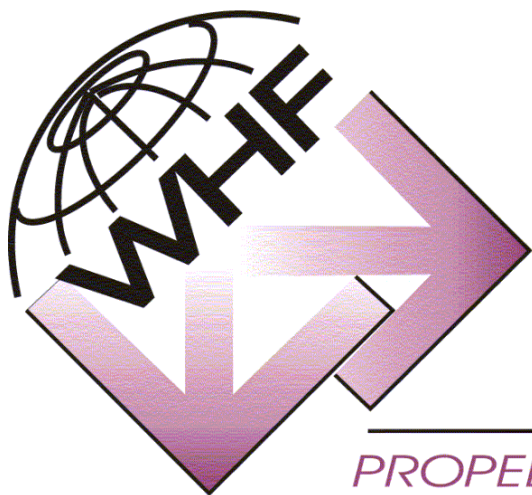

World Hovercraft Championships 2018 in Germany.

Manuel Jessica & Metzner, the German organisers of the "Sparkassen Hovercraft World Championships 2018", have asked that the following documents are made available to you.

Conditions for registration to "Sparkassen Hovercraft World Championship 2018" at Saalburg

1. The event will take place from 2018-09-04 to 2018-09-09 at Saalburg.
2. The participants can enter to the event site/paddock/camping area from 2018-09-02 at 10:00 am.
3. Unfortunately we can't offer any electricity for the teams.
4. The event area must be left until 2018-09-10 at 4:00 pm.
5. For a successful registration please fill in the entry form and send it back to us – via Mail: j.metzner@amk-info-verlag.de or via fax: 0049 3663 425295. (address: Jessica Metzner, Ludwig-Jahn-Straße 4a, 07907 Schleiz)
6. The entry fee is 100 EUR per driver; 60 EUR for Formula Junior when you send the registration until 2018-08-01. After this date the entry fee is 135 EUR per driver; 100 EUR for Formula Junior. The entry fee must be transferred to the following bank account until 2018-09-03:

7. The entry fee contains the access to the racecourse, entry tickets for one driver and two team-members and also the transponder rental. Insurance is not included but can be made on site. It costs 25 EUR per driver.
8. If there are more than two team-members they can receive their tickets for 15 EUR per person at the entry of the paddock and must be paid immediately. Entry is only allowed with a valid ticket.
9. Drivers will need a transponder for time keeping – the transponders are provided by the organizer. There has to be paid a deposit of approx. 30 EUR when you pick up the transponder. In case of loss, the transponder has to be replaced.
10. Authorized to the races are only hovercrafts that correspondent to the current rules and they must be checked by the technical acceptance.
11. Every participant has to ensure that there are no environmental damages caused by his hovercraft or his behavior. Any waste oil has to be disposed in the container that is intended for that. Every participant receives trash bags at the entry of the paddock that must be disposed at the special place for waste.
12. You will find toilets directly at the event site, showers are at the camping area nearby.
13. The organizer takes care for a sufficient catering in a tent. At the evenings there will be different parties for all participants and their teams (for example "Oktoberfest")
14. The official opening party will take place on Friday 7:00 pm in the tent. All participants and teams are asked to take part and to represent their country for the guests, sponsors and officials. (preferably with country flag)
15. A special dinner for all participants and the teams will take place on Saturday 6:30 pm in the tent. The tickets are available on site.
16. We want to collect as much interesting information for guests as possible from the participants/teams to print a program booklet, and also for the speaker for the event. So please send us a little text and pictures from you / your team to help us until 2018-08-01 via mail to j.metzner@amk-info-verlag.de Thank you!

WHF Board Meeting.

Our next WHF Board meeting will be held at 10.00 hrs on Monday 10th September at Saalburg (venue to be confirmed). Formal invitations and agendas will be sent out by e-mail two weeks before the meeting. Within reason all are welcome but only eligible country representative, or their nominated representative, have voting rights.

When you receive the agenda, you will note that there are several major items for discussion at the meeting. These include:

- **Election of Board Members:**

If you wish to nominate a Board Member please first of all get their permission and then notify our Secretary at least three weeks before the Board meeting.

- **Future World Championships**

If you wish to make a bid for the next World Championships in 2020, or indeed further into the future please will you send your bid or indication to our Secretary no later than three weeks before the meeting so that it can be included on the agenda. At the time of compiling this bulleting we do not have any bids on the table.

WHF Board Meeting (continued).

- **Items for the Agenda:**

If there are any items that you wish the WHF to add to its agenda please discuss this with your country representative who will arrange to do this. Any item should be supported by a proposal and full explanation and sent to our Secretary by your country representative no later than three weeks before the Board meeting. This will be circulated with the meeting papers, or earlier if received in good time to give everyone the opportunity to consider or debate them before the meeting.

- **Member's reports:**

Each member country is invited to submit a report on the hovercraft activities in their country. The purpose of this is to allow us all and the WHF in particular, to see how our sport is developing world wide. PLEASE make sure your Country Representative submits a brief report on your hovercraft activities for the past two years to our Secretary three weeks before the Board meeting. These will then be circulated to all prior to the meeting.

And a Final REMINDER.

Please do discuss any of the above issues, or other matters that concern you, with your colleagues and your Country's representative. This way the WHF can take your views into account and develop for the future.
