Addendum to Special World Championship 2006 Bulletin 14 August 2006

Since circulating Bulletin 14 an error has been noticed. The earliest arrival date at the race site is Sunday 20th of August (not September!).

Also as the final programme for the event is nearing completion the organizers have notified us of some other minor changes. These are set out below.

Restriction of Formula Entries:

- Good news - After carefully considering the racing programme the Organizers have found sufficient time to include some extra heats. This means that Drivers may now enter both F50 and FS. There are four Drivers who have registered for F2, F50 and FS. However, in order to help with the logistics of organization these Drivers will be restricted to just two formulae and at registration they will be asked to nominate which ones.

Restriction of Practice:

- Again to help with logistics Drivers who are in two formulas with the same craft may only practice in one formula. This does **not** apply to time trials.

WHF Fees:

- Each Driver is required pay a 5€ WHF fee **in cash** on registration. This is being collected by the Organizers on behalf of the WHF. **There are not any entry charges being made by the Organizers for the Championships.**

Saturday Evening Celebration Meal:

- Non driver meal tickets cost 15€ each and must be paid in cash at registration by Tuesday 22nd August. There are a maximum of 600 places and these will be distributed to those already registered. Any new request will be added to a "waiting list" which already has 20 on it.
